The early winter session will run from December 5<sup>th</sup> through February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Students are expected to be present at the after school sessions. Students enrolled in Learning Recovery to recoup a quarter grade will be required to successfully complete 5-10 hours/lessons per quarter failed in order to earn a quarter grade of 65. Although the Learning Recovery program is not mandatory, they offer Longwood High School students who are currently failing a course a unique opportunity to be met with success.
