

EATON LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Each year, the Eaton Lions Club provides two \$500.00 scholarship paid in two installments of \$250 each to a graduating senior to assist in financing his college education. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the Bursar of the college of the student's choice and credited to their account. A letter of confirmation of the student's registration must be sent from the college to the Scholarship Committee of the Lions Club.

Applications are now being accepted with the following requirements:

1. Applicant must be an Eaton High School graduating senior.
2. Applicant must plan to attend, or be enrolled in an accredited college or university. The funds will not be distributed until final proof of admission is shown to the Selection Committee. Portions of the scholarship not paid will be forfeited if the recipient leaves school for any reason.
3. Students interested in applying for the Eaton Lions Club Scholarship must complete an application form which is available at the high school guidance office.
4. Applications must be returned before the specified deadline to the high school guidance office. All information requested on the application form must be completed in full. Also, the attached recommendation form shall be filled out by a teacher and/or guidance counselor.
5. A committee of Lions Club members will review the applications and make the final selection to be announced at the annual High School Awards Assembly.
