There will be a Youth Fun Run (ages 13 and under) from 2 to 3 pm and 2 mile run for ages 14 and up starting at 3 pm.

"They've written grant applications and business proposals, and they've looked critically at the positive differences they can make in their community," said Mrs. Garee. 
