2022-2023 CVUSD Secondary Reclassification Criteria - Grades 7-12 This reclassification criteria is in reference to English Learners taking the Summative ELPAC. Semester grades of 70% or higher in ELA are recommended to meet Reclassification Criteria. Special Education students who can successfully complete all four sections of ELPAC are part of this criteria. Some EL students with unique needs, or dually-identified students, may need specific General Information considerations for how this criterion is met as described in the student's individualized education plan (IEP). In such instances, members of the student's IEP team should confer to document and discuss how the student's unique needs affect their ability to obtain an Overall PL 4 -CDF Criteria 1: Assessment of Students scoring a PL4 (well developed) ELPAC scale score will be considered "proficient" in this category. Students English FI PAC designated to take the Alternate ELPAC scoring a PL3 will be considered "proficient" in this category. Language Proficiency Criteria 2: Teacher recommendation based on overall student performance and teacher observation. Teacher makes Teacher Grades recommendation prior to parent meeting and may be present during LAT meeting or IEP meeting. **Evaluations** *Report card marks/grades in English Language Arts must be at least 70% (A, B, or C).
