- ➔ Questions about your child's progress.

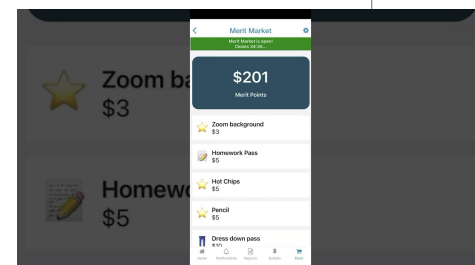
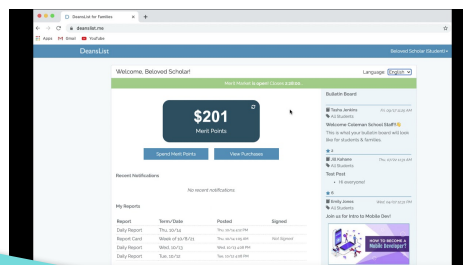
### Ask Important Questions

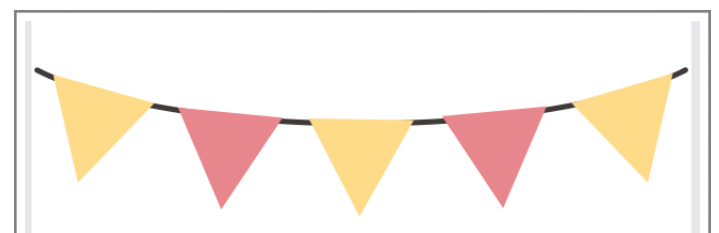

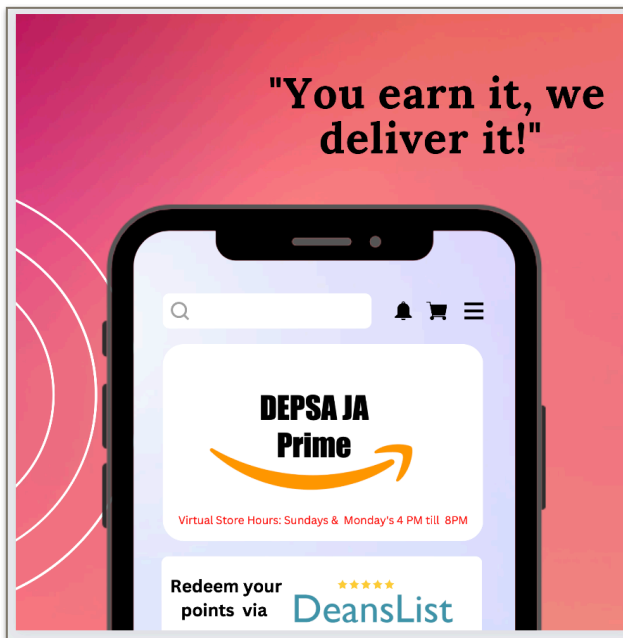
