Pollution Concerns

- ◆ Excessive Nitrogen and Phosphorus
 - ◆ Found in sanitary wastes
 - ◆ Fertilizers
- ◆ Construction/Road Runoff
- ◆ Industrial wastewater



Nitrogen and Phosphorus

- ◆ Nitrogen and Phosphorus – essential nutrients for plant growth
- ◆ Both occur naturally and are important to the ecosystem
- ◆ Excessive nutrients lead to:
 - ◆ Eutrophication
 - ◆ Algae blooms
 - ◆ Reduced oxygen



Construction Runoff

- 💧 Leads to large amounts of sedimentation
- 💧 Can carry petroleum products from construction vehicles
- 💧 Concrete truck washout



Industrial Waste Water

- 💧 Multitude of chemicals produced by industry
- 💧 Regular testing of discharges
- 💧 May have water retention areas



Stormwater Management

- ◆ State and national SPDES Programs
- ◆ Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP)
 - ◆ Construction
 - ◆ Industry
- ◆ Sewer and Sanitary Regulations
- ◆ Phosphorus ban in detergents and fertilizers



State Pollution Elimination Discharge System

◆ Program Goals

- ◆ Eliminate pollution from state waters
- ◆ Maintain highest possible water quality
- ◆ Protection of public health
- ◆ Public enjoyment of resources
- ◆ Protect fish and wildlife
- ◆ Manage industrial development



SWPPP

- SWPPP components
 - Site map and description
 - Activities that could cause pollution
 - Management Practices and Control Measures
 - Inspections and Monitoring
- Briarcliff Manor has a SWPPP
 - Community Outreach
 - Inspections
 - Annual report

What to do at home

- 💧 Fertilize lawns only as needed
- 💧 Handle and store fertilizers and other household chemicals properly
- 💧 Direct roof downspouts towards vegetative areas
- 💧 Direct downspouts into rain barrels
- 💧 Consider porous options for paved areas



What to do at home Continued

- Plant a rain garden
- Plant native species
- Reduce use of pesticides and herbicides
- Wash cars at a carwash
