Good Afternoon,

It is my pleasure to announce our new partnership with Boys and Girls Club of Cheyenne to provide after school and Friday programming for our elementary students. This new venture is the culmination of years of planning. We hope it is a great opportunity for our community.

As with many new initiatives, there are many questions. Below are some basics that I hope help you with your planning. Please visit with your student's principal for more information.

Boys and Girls Club Basics

Boys and Girls Club of Cheyenne (BGCC) will be offering after school programs on Monday through Thursday until 6:00 at the Burns Elementary and Pine Bluffs Elementary schools for students who are 5 years old (registered as a Kindergarten student) through 6th grade. Even though the schools are hosting, BGCC is staffing the programming and is in charge. Here are some additional details for the M-Th programming:

- Parents need to register their children with BGCC in order to participate.
- No transportation home.
- Parents or a guardian must pick up by 6:00 each day.
- Students from Carpenter Elementary will be transported to Burns Elementary to participate.
- Any student who started the school year as a 4 year old, cannot participate, even when they turn 5 sometime during the school year.
- A snack will be provided.
- Program will not run on ½ days or Early Release Days.

BGCC will also be providing a Friday program for Laramie 2 students aged 5 years old through 6th grade at the Burns Elementary and Pine Bluffs Elementary schools. This program will start at 10:00 on Fridays and end at 6:00 in the evening. Here are some details for the Friday programming.

- Parents need to register their children with BGCC in order to participate.
- No transportation home.
- Parents or a guardian must pick up by 6:00 each day.
- Transportation is available for pick-up in the morning IF, and ONLY IF, the student participates in the school-led Intervention Time from 8:00 to 10:00.
 - Parents will need to work with the school to secure a need for transportation.
 - Transportation will not be provided on Yellow Days. BGCC Friday school will still start at 10:00.
- Any student who started the school year as a 4 year old, cannot participate, even when they turn 5 sometime during the school year.
- A snack and sack lunch will be provided.

Full day programs, such as this Friday Program, will not be available during any school holiday.
