# FOOD SERVICES



## PAYING FOR SCHOOL MEALS

1. Pay Online: Use your computer or smartphone to make payments, view your child's account balance or see what they're eating! Visit [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com) to register.
2. Pay by Mail: Send a check to the school payable to "Fairfield Local Food Service". Please include your child's name and ID number. (11611 St. Rt. 771 Leesburg, Ohio 45135)
3. Pay in Person/Send Payment to School: Stop by the school office during school hours to pay by cash or check. Or send cash or check to school with your child. Please place in envelope with child's name and ID number on the outside.

We encourage parents to create a "safety net" for their child. Pre-paying for your child's meals prevents unpaid meal charges. Paying for meals ahead of time also helps lines move more quickly, giving children more time to enjoy their lunch break.

You will receive automated calls if your child's account balance is low or in the negative. Students with a \$-5.50 balance (or greater) will receive an alternate meal (cheese sandwich or PBJ, fruit, veggie and milk). The student will receive alternate meals until the account is in good standing. No a-la-carte or extra items can be charged.

## **FREE OR REDUCED MEALS**

Fairfield Local Schools participates in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs. We offer FREE or REDUCED-PRICED meals to children who are eligible. ***Participation is confidential.***

***Each year, the income guidelines change for these benefits. Even if you did not qualify last year, you may qualify this year.*** It is recommended that ALL FAMILIES complete and return the Free/Reduced Meal Application that will be sent home with your child the first day of school.

Families that qualify may also be eligible to receive free health care through *Healthy Start & Healthy Families*. For more information, call 1-800-324-8680.

## **BREAKFAST**

Studies show that kids perform better when they start their day with a healthy meal.

Breakfast is offered to every student (K-12) every day school is in session, except days where a 2-hour delay is observed. Breakfast is served in a "grab and go" style. Students in grades K-4 eat their breakfast in the auditoria before going to class. Students in grades 5-12 take their breakfast to the classroom to eat.

We offer many choices for breakfast. A hot item is offered each day, along with many other options, including cereal, breakfast bars, fruit, juice and milk.

The **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act** (FERPA) and Ohio law generally prohibit the disclosure of personally identifiable information from students' education records without prior consent. An exception exists in both federal and Ohio law to allow publishing directory information in places such as the yearbook, honor roll, graduation program or sports rosters. "Directory Information" is information generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released. The following can be designated as directory information: student's name, address, telephone number, email address, date and place of birth, dates of attendance, grade level, sports participation, degrees, honors, awards and weight/height of members of athletic team participants.

If you do not want Fairfield Local School District to disclose directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the District in writing by September 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Elementary Parent Notification**

As a recipient of Federal Title 1 funding, Fairfield Elementary is required to notify parents of elementary students of their right to know about the professional qualifications of our elementary teachers. You have the right to know:

- If the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas being taught.
- If the teacher is teaching under a temporary or emergency status in which state qualifications or licensing are waived.
- The teacher's baccalaureate degree major, graduate licensure, and field of discipline
- Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and, if so, their qualifications.

The **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act** affords parents and students who are 18 years of age or older ("eligible students") certain rights with respect to the student's education records. These rights are:

- The right to inspect and review the student's education records within 45 days after the day the Fairfield Local School District ("School") receives a request for access.
- The right to request the amendment of the student's education records that the parent or eligible student believes are inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of the student's privacy rights under FERPA.
- The right to provide written consent before the school discloses personally identifiable information (PII) from the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.

**Child Find Policy** The Fairfield Local School District's adopted Child Find Policy requires that all children below twenty-two (22) years of age residing within the district, who have a disability regardless of the severity of the disability, and who are in need of special education and related services are identified, located, and evaluated in accordance with all federal regulations and state standards.

For children birth through age two, a disability means that a child has a behavior, cognition, communication, physical development, sensory development and/or social or emotional development deficit.

For children age three through five years of age, a disability means that a child has a documented deficit in one or more of the following areas: communication skills, hearing abilities, motor functioning, social emotional/behavior functioning or vision abilities.

For school-age children, a disability means a person having one or more conditions such as autism, developmental handicap, hearing handicap, multi-handicap, orthopedically and/or other health handicaps, emotional/behavior handicap, specific learning disability, traumatic brain injury or vision handicap.

## SCHOOLMESSENGER

The Fairfield Local School District will continue to use the automated notification service *SchoolMessenger*. This system is used for closings, delays, athletic events, school activities, absences and lunchroom account notifications.

For *SchoolMessenger* to operate effectively, we need accurate contact information for our students. If at any time your phone numbers change, please notify the school immediately so you will continue to receive calls.

## LOCKERS

Under Ohio Revised Code 3313.20, "all lockers are the property of the Board of Education and lockers and their contents are subject to random search at any time without regard to whether there is reasonable suspicion that any locker or its contents contains evidence of a violation of a criminal statute or a school rule."



The **Emergency Management Team**, continues to meet several times each school year with local medical and law enforcement personnel. The purpose of these meetings is to continue discussing the safety and well-being of our students, staff, visitors and the community.

In addition to the routine fire and tornado drills, Fairfield students will be participating in Lock-down and Evacuation drills during the school year. These drills are unannounced and are intended to simulate a real emergency situation. Local law enforcement and other emergency personnel may take part in these drills. At the completion of a lockdown/evacuation drill, a message will be sent to all families indicating that a drill has taken place.

## Waiting for and Getting on/off the Bus

- When waiting for the bus, stay away from traffic
- Stay away from the street or road as the bus approaches
- Wait for bus to stop & doors to open before getting on
- Use the handrail when boarding and exiting
- Walk at 10 feet in front of the bus so driver can see you
- Wait for a signal from the driver before crossing
- Watch traffic for changes
- Stay away from the rear wheels of the bus at all times

## Behavior on the Bus

- Don't speak loudly or make loud noises that could distract the driver
- Stay in your seat / Don't put your head, arms or hands out the window
- Keep aisles clear of books and bags
- Get your belongings together before reaching your stop
- Wait for the bus to stop completely before getting up from your seat
