SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY



ROME

Marymount International School, an independent college-preparatory school located near the historical center of Rome.



RSHM

Established in 1946 by the Religious of the Sacred Heart of Mary to provide an American education, in English, based on Christian values.



K-12

Coeducational day school for grades preK-12. Students come from across the city and include business, NGO, professional and diplomatic families; most are fluent in at least two languages.



Diversity

79 Nationalities are represented in the student body. Of the total high school enrollment, 34 are American citizens; 112 Italian; and 133 represent other countries.



46 Languages

Many languages are spoken on campus. These include: Italian, Arabic, French, Spanish, Danish, Croatian, Chinese, Korean, Singhalese, Russian, German, Amharic and Farsi.



Faculty

Of the 59 secondary faculty, 2\3 have advanced degrees. Second language instruction is provided by faculty members in Arabic, English, French, German, Italian, Latin and Mandarin.

CURRICULUM FEATURES

The International Baccalaureate Program (IB) is offered in Grades 11 and 12. This two-year program is a rigorous pre-university course of study culminating in external examinations. To earn an IB Diploma, a candidate is required to pass examinations in 6 subjects, 3 at the Higher Level and 3 at the Standard Level. These must include: **2 languages, 1 social studies, 1 laboratory science, 1 mathematics, and a sixth subject** which may be art, music, or another of the first 5 disciplines. Diploma candidates must also follow a course in Theory of Knowledge, submit an Extended Essay, and participate in social service. In addition, Marymount Rome offers AP courses. In 2021-22, we offered AP English Language and Composition, AP World History and AP Biology. In 2022-23 the school is offering AP Environmental Science, AP US Government & Politics and AP English Language & Composition. Of the 78 students in the Class of 2022, 59 were IB Diploma candidates and 10 others sat for examinations in one or more subjects to earn certificates.

While the COVID-19 pandemic hit Italy very hard, Marymount was able to remain fully open for in-person learning throughout the entire 2021-22 school year. All AP and IB exams were administered in person. The school maintained its grading and assessment standards throughout this challenging time.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A student must earn a minimum **21 CREDITS** distributed as follows:

- 4 English**
- 4 Foreign Language**
- 3 Social Studies**
- 3 Mathematics**
- 3 Science (inc. 1 Lab Science)**
- 2 Religious Studies**
- 1 Physical Ed.**
- 1 Fine Arts**

TESTING

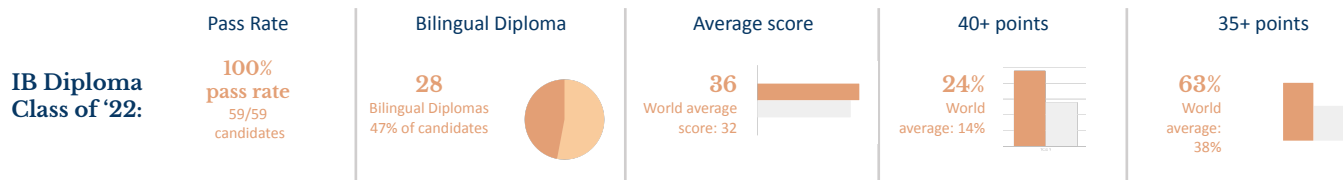
All students are given the opportunity to take the PSAT and the SAT at school. Three Advanced Placement courses are offered each year. The vast majority of students in Grades 11 and 12 are IB Diploma candidates, and nearly all others are IB Certificate candidates.

Test Scores:

SAT: 35 SAT's Taken in 2020-21. Middle 50 percent verbal (550-640); Middle 50 percent Math (530-660)

GRADING AND RANKING

Due to the degree of transiency and the variety of grading systems in international schools, students are NOT ranked; published GPAs are calculated only for the time students spend in grades 9-12 at Marymount. School standards are rigorous. Final grades are given at the end of each semester. Grades in non-IB courses are reported as letters, A-F, and GPAs are calculated on the 4-point scale outlined below.

UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS

Approximately 96% of Marymount's students go on to further education immediately after high school.

IB MATHEMATICS AT MARYMOUNT

We offer three IB Mathematics courses. The most rigorous is IB Math Analysis and Approaches Higher Level; it focuses on calculus. This course is often equated with AP Calculus BC. The second most challenging math course at Marymount is IB Math Analysis and Approaches Standard Level; it also dedicates a significant amount of time to differential calculus. The third course at the IB level is IB Math Application and Interpretation Standard Level which includes calculus but is more focused on probability and statistics.

CO-CURRICULUM

Marymount offers after school activities in languages, Model United Nations and Varsity sports. In addition, there are numerous student-run clubs, an annual yearbook and a literary magazine. The students who are inducted into the National Honor Society are present at the school's public events to host visitors and provide language help to parents who may not speak English comfortably.
