Students must receive the classroom teacher's written consent on the **PINK College Visit Pass** (available in the Guidance Department) **PRIOR** to the date of the session they wish to attend. In school visits must be scheduled at least 1 day before the event. There is a limit of 25 participants in the Guidance Conference Room.

VIRTUAL COLLEGE VISITS not conducted at HS East. They begin after 3:00 pm based on the schedule the college/university selected.
