Dear friends and people of Our Lady of Good Counsel,

Greetings and Peace to you from God our Father, and Our lord Jesus Christ.

Advent is a season about time. This season before Christmas is a time of preparation. We prepare ourselves, yes, to celebrate the Birth of our Lord and Savior on Christmas, but a closer look at the Bible readings for our Sunday worship calls on us to prepare ourselves for the time when our Lord shall return in the Glory of the Father.

And my hope is that by spending Advent in this way, we will be transformed from "wasters of time" into "appreciators of time," so that when we gather to worship on Christmas, we may enter into a deeper appreciation for what God has done to and for you and me. He has come to this world, he has broken through to us from his eternal habitation and promised to be with us always guiding and guarding, leading, and protecting us, even to the end of time.

Our Lady of Good Counsel School provides a Catholic education instilled with the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales. As part of its educational program, OLGC School strives for academic excellence, encourages appreciation of the fine arts, fosters self-respect and respect for all life, and attempts to develop responsibility for the total community.

Students who desire an educational experience founded on the Catholic philosophy of education, and who fulfill the age, health, academic, and behavioral requirements, are eligible for admission to OLGC School. Preschool students must be at least 3 years of age by September 30 of the year the child enters Preschool. Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age by September 30 of the year the child enters Kindergarten.


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR TAX SEASON

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program provides free tax preparation to qualified individuals and families in Northern Virginia. Fairfax County Dept. of Family Services is recruiting volunteers to act as greeters, interpreters (including ASL), screeners, tax preparers, online tax coaches, social media outreach, and IT support. No experience is necessary but volunteers must be 19 and older. Free training (classroom and online) is available for screeners and tax preparers. No tax training is needed for greeters and interpreters. To register as a volunteer please visit volunteer. 
