- Fergus County Medical Society** (College, University or Vo-Tech) – For an FHS graduating senior pursuing a career in a healthcare field.
- Fergus Federal Credit Union Scholarship** (College, University or Vo-Tech) – For Central Montana graduating seniors. Applicant or parent must be a member.
- Friendship Lodge #37 – Masonic Scholarship** (College, University or Vo-Tech) – Four-year scholarships for Fergus, Roy or Winifred graduating seniors. **Attachment required.**
