Item Title: CSP #23-160 Commingled (Single-Stream) Recycling Service District-wide X Action Information Discussion

BACKGROUND:

The District is committed to recycling the materials it uses and to minimizing non-hazardous waste. It will be the responsibility of every member of the District to support these efforts designed to protect the environment by conserving resources and preserving rapidly diminishing landfill space.

Policy CL Regulation

On November 2020, the District initiated the Commingled (Single-Stream) Recycling Service District-wide. Collection containers were placed at all campuses and district buildings housing departments in a systematic implementation to ensure successful collection of cardboard, paper, plastics and aluminum.

To continue the program, a Competitive Seal Proposal was advertised in the local newspaper, posted on the BISD Purchasing Department website and one hundred thirty-two (132) vendors were notified. Two (2) proposals were received and three (3) no-bid.

Amount expended for the previous 24 months \$322,200.00.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Not to exceed \$843,000.00 from Local Maintenance Funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend approval of CSP #23-160 Commingled (Single-Stream) Recycling Service District-Wide to Redfish Recycling (Marck Industries of Texas) of Brownsville, Texas for one (1) year term with an option to renew for two (2) additional one year term (3 years term in total).
