

OAKWOOD SCHOOLS FOUNDATION – RADER-DRUMMER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established in 2018 by Carlee (Rader) and Michael Drummer, graduates of the class of 1968. This scholarship recognizes an outstanding and motivated student who intends to attend an accredited college or university and major in architecture or the liberal arts such as English, theater, art, communications, foreign languages, history, music, or philosophy. Preference will be given to English or architecture majors.

Scholarship Criteria

- Be a graduating senior from Oakwood High School
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Be accepted to an accredited four-year college or university as a full-time student
- Plan to major in architecture or the liberal arts such as English, theater, art, communications, foreign languages, history, music, or philosophy. Preference will be given to English or architecture majors.
- Demonstrate financial need, if all else is equal.

Application Process

The scholarship application will be available online at ScholarshipCONNECT at www.daytonfoundation.org in December of each year. Applicants will need to complete all sections of the online application in order to be considered.

Use of the Scholarship

The scholarship may be used for tuition only.

Size and Frequency of the Scholarship

One scholarship of at least \$1,000 may be offered annually.

Selection Process

A Scholarship Selection Committee appointed by The Dayton Foundation will review all applications and may elect not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.

Payment of the Scholarship

The Selection Committee will submit the name of the recommended scholarship recipient to The Dayton Foundation's Governing Board on an annual basis. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student's school after the student has confirmed enrollment.
