Dental Screenings - December 12th

As per the RI Department of Health school guidelines, dental screenings are required to be done yearly in all RI schools. These screenings must be performed on students in grades K-5 and once for grades 6-10 yearly. We will be screening our elementary aged students and grade 8 on Monday, December 12th.

George Resnevic, DMD will be coming out to Mercymount to provide this service. It is a noninvasive exam. He will be looking in the students mouth with a flashlight and disposable mirror. Every student screened will come home with a Dental Screening Findings report that provides the parents with any treatment recommendations.

Students who have an updated dental card or letter on file stating their last visit to their own dentist will be exempt from this screening. Letters or cards must be dated after 5/17/22. Dental cards are available online at:
