
Addressing the needs of multilingual learners in our dual language program by using the American Reading Company (ARC) resources




Impact: SEL Classroom Data October 2022


Classroom Set up/Social Emotional Components

Impact

- Increased opportunities to elevate student voice, highlight strengths, and collectively grow
- Unique strengths are celebrated by teachers and classmates
- Students know each other by name
- Class as a safe space for students to celebrate and address harm caused through restorative approach
 - Learning is responsive to immediate needs (ex: Kindness challenge, discussions on racist language and its impact)

49% of All Mount View staff are fluently multilingual!








