Recipes & Things to Do

Tasty Apple Cider

To make a delicious apple cider, you will need **10 large apples** cut into fourths. If you do not have fresh apples, use apple juice. You will also need one cut **orange**, **4 cinnamon sticks**, 1 teaspoon of **cloves** (if you do not have this, no worries), 1 teaspoon of **Allspice**, 1 whole **nutmeg**, and 1/2 a cup of **brown sugar**. First, in a large pot, add the apples, oranges, spices, and brown sugar. Fill the pot with water until it is 2 inches deep. Bring to boil. Next, reduce the heat to simmer. Cover for 2 hours. After 2 hours, remove the oranges and mash the apples. Cover for 1 more hour. Lastly, strain the cider into a pitcher. This recipe makes half a gallon or 2 quarts. The prep time will take 10 minutes, and total time will take 3 hours and 15 minutes. Enjoy this tasty fall treat on a crisp fall morning!
