Student Investment Account (SIA) Priorities

Reducing class size

Increase instructional assistants to increase behavioral supports, decrease caseloads, and support transitions.
Increase licensed special education staff at the middle school and high school

Well Rounded Education

Increase access to arts education
Increase access to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)
Increase access to culturally responsive teaching and materials
Increase High School FTE to support emerging CTE
Increase experiences for middle school students to learn about pathways to college and career education
Support school transition programs and activities

Instructional Time

Support for before, after, and night school programs providing targeted student support
After school programs
Extended time and FTE to offer high school courses for credit during the summer
Summer school programs

Health and Safety

FTE to enhance systems of support for student mental and behavioral health and safety.
