

# A.L.E.X.

## Academy of Learning Extension

Laramie County School District Number Two (LCSD #2) continues to offer an after school program for ALL elementary students currently enrolled in LCSD #2.

A.L.E.X. is an extended school day program offered to students in grades K-6. This extension of the regular school day provides additional time for homework assistance, corrective instruction, and enrichment activities. LCSD #2 offers the A.L.E.X. program at Burns Elementary and Pine Bluffs Elementary at no charge to parents. Funding for A.L.E.X. is through state and federal funding sources. Bussing is provided for students at Carpenter Elementary and Albin Elementary. Parents will be responsible for picking up their children from A.L.E.X. locations no later than 6:00 p.m. on regular school days.

The A.L.E.X. program is offered to students Monday through Friday when the regular school day ends at 3:00 until 6:00 p.m. A.L.E.X will not be available for students on early release days. Please follow the current school calendar.

A.L.E.X. will not be in session on dates where there is no school in the afternoon.
