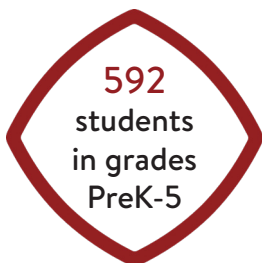
ABOUT STEM

- We are a PreK through grade 5 elementary magnet school located in Richfield, a first-ring suburb just south of Minneapolis.
- Our focus is educating students through a science, technology, engineering and math lens.
- This STEM approach partners with the District-adopted curriculum to ensure students are receiving a strong foundation in all content areas while preparing them for future opportunities in STEM.

HIGHLIGHTS

- We are a Google school that utilizes Chromebooks (including a tablet version) for students to express and share their learning. Technology is embedded into the regular classroom along with a specialist class that is provided on a regular basis.
- Extended learning opportunities are available through community partnerships, field trips and school assemblies. Partner organizations include Wood Lake Nature Center, the University of Minnesota, the Mayo Clinic, Exploradome and Science House.
- A schoolwide system of support that includes English Language Learners, Newcomer Academy, Accelerated Learners and Special Education.
- After school activities include Future Problem Solvers, ALC (Math & Reading interventions), and regionally-competitive Lego League.
- Additional STEM spaces are used to deepen student learning. These dedicated spaces include the science lab, WOW (engineering lab), outdoor garden, technology lab and media center.
