Early Childhood Programs



The focus of our early learning programs is to provide children with a high quality and engaging learning experience that will ignite a love of learning and prepare them for kindergarten. We offer preschool for three and

four year olds, as well as Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) for ages 12 to 36 months.

Community Education

at partner locations around the area during the daytime, after school and evening hours.

Transportation Boundaries



While families can enroll their child in any of our four elementary schools, transportation to the two neighborhood schools—Sheridan Hills and Centennial—is determined by your home address.

Families who live west of Nicollet Avenue will get busing to Sheridan Hills and families living east of Nicollet Avenue will get busing to Centennial.

Districtwide busing is available to either of the magnet schools—Richfield Dual Language School or Richfield STEM Elementary.
