- Of course, your book should be grammatically correct, school-appropriate, polished, and entertaining.
- In addition to writing your book, we're going to have story time in class, during which you'll have to read your book to the class. Your reading is really a performance as if you were reading to a group of kids (intonation). Of course, your pronunciation must be perfect as well. If you work with a group, everyone must participate equally in the reading.
- You will have to turn in a copy of your written story (en español) early in the process, and a large portion of your grade is based on the writing in your story. Make sure you check your grammar, spelling, etc. A LOT!
