

## 2022-2023 Testing Schedule for STRIDE Academy

To ensure that all students have access to standards-based content and instruction, the MCA and MTAS are administered statewide. Most Minnesota students take the MCA. Students who receive special education services and meet eligibility requirements may take the MTAS.

Access and Alternate ACCESS are the annual English proficiency assessments for English learners. The assessments measure a student's English proficiency in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. The language development standards for these tests are developed by the WIDA Consortium and were adopted by Minnesota in 2011.

### ADDITIONAL ASSESSMENTS 2021-2022

STRIDE Academy gives each student a test called Measures of Academic Progress (MAP). These tests are part of the Northwest Evaluation Assessments or NWEA. We give students MAP tests to determine each child's instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Reading and Math for students in kindergarten through sixth grade. Staff analyzes data from NWEA to set our school goals, individual as well as school wide.

The teachers use the data from the tests to guide their instruction, determine specific skills and concepts that need to be taught and specific strengths and weaknesses of each student, and the class as a whole.
