Girls Basketball:

The 7th grade girls basketball team opened the season with a win over Trotwood Madison, 47-4. Alayna Toney led all scorers with 19 points followed by Isla Wooten with 12.

The 8th grade girls basketball team beat Trotwood Madison 35-15 in their season opener. Janaya Scott led all scorers with 9 points.

Alayna Toney led the 7th grade team with 10 points as they took their first loss of the season, to Northridge, 25-14. The Lady Climbers are 1-1 on the season.

The 8th grade girls team took on Northridge and came out on top with a 39-22 victory. Addi Hegyi led all scorers with 12 points. Lola Rice added 11 followed by Olivia MacKendrick with another 10 points. The Lady Climbers remain unbeaten with a 2-0 record.

The 7th grade girls basketball team traveled to Stivers and came home with a 32-20 win! Alayna Toney led the team with 14 points. The Lady Climbers are 2-1. The 8th grade girls fought hard to hold off Stivers and take the victory 35-34. Addi Hegyi led the team with 12 points. The 8th grade Lady Climbers improve to 3-0.

Remind

Log in to your Remind account on a computer
Click your name in the upper left-hand corner

Once added, you will need to confirm your new device through a 4-digit confirmation code; so make sure you can easily access your landline and/or mobile number.

Open the app

Tap the settings icon located to the right of your name

Select "Notifications"

Tap the three vertical dots next to the right of the device

Select turn off notifications, turn on notifications, or select remove from account to delete a device

Tap "Add phone or email" at the bottom to connect another device to your Remind account
