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



ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




School Goals




State Goals

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

RGS is a PBIS school. We teach and positively reinforce expected student behaviors. Student supports include in classroom brain break stations, a Sensory Zone, teaching Zones of Regulation and use of Social Thinking curriculum. Middle School instruction emphasizes responsible use of technology and discussions on responsible use of social media. We utilize restorative practices to help students repair relationships and restore community.


