




CLASS SIZE

Median size of classes in core subjects.




Academic Success

ON-TIME GRADUATION Students earning a diploma within four years.




School Goals


REGULAR ATTENDERS

Safe & Welcoming Environment

District and school safety committees have been actively planning for increased security measures to keep students safe. This year we implemented a buzz-in entry system at a single point of entry. All other entries to the school are locked during the school day. This system brings added security to our building. We also continue to use the following safety procedures: a multiagency threat assessment team, routine lock down and lock out drills, safety tip lines, connecting students with mental health services, staff training in run/hide/fight strategies, and partnership with our community resource officers.


