

# FAQ

- What are school opening and closing times?

*Doors open at 7:35 for breakfast. If you are not having breakfast doors open at 7:45. Classes start at 7:50. School gets out at 3:15*

- How do I report my child's absence?

*Please call the attendance line at 303-622-9211 ext.788 and leave a message. You can also email Ms. Hall at [jhall@strasburg31j.com](mailto:jhall@strasburg31j.com). Please report your child's absence before 9:30 am.*

- What do I do if my child is prescribed medication?

*If your child needs to have any medication at school you must complete a form at the school office. It must be signed by the parent/guardian and the child's doctor. This is including Ibuprofen and Tylenol. All medication held on school premises is kept locked and secure.*

- How long till my child can return to school after an illness?

*We ask that children remain at home until they are well enough to return to school.*

*Sickness (fever) and stomach bugs – we ask that children remain at home for 24 hours after their last bout of illness to ensure that infections do not spread.*

- What do I do if I need to see a teacher?

*Please email your child's teacher with their school emails listed on the website to set up an appointment.*

- What clubs are there?

*Chess/Strategy club, Homework club, Dungeons & Dragons club, and Future Christian Athletes (FCA) club.*

- What should I do if I am worried about my child's progress?

*Check PowerSchool. PowerSchool will provide you with your child's grades, missing assignments, and attendance information. If you need your login information for PowerSchool please contact the office.*

- How many service hours does my child need? What is acceptable?

*Your child needs 18 hours total. Voluntary service that benefits the community. Voluntary service in a non-profit organization ie..church, shelter, food bank, senior citizen facility, hospital, zoo, rescue mission. Voluntary service that benefits the school (done after school hours). Voluntary service that benefits a community member that is outside your regular routine or obligation. All aspects of the service must have approval of your parent/guardian.*

- There is a 2 hour delay, what does that mean?

*During a two hour delay school will start at 9:50. Just add two hours to the normal time you would drop off your child.*
