The committee will continue with its weekly meetings for the foreseeable future. Meeting agendas, related documents and minutes can be found on the Greenwich Public Schools website. The committee has organized into several sub-committees to expedite processes and share the workload.

As of the date of this report an Owner's Rep has been selected and agreement execution is pending. The company chosen as the Owner's Rep will be made public upon contract execution. After a competitive bidding process with proposals submitted by eight firms, the Building Committee has chosen Construction Solutions Group of East Hartford, CT as provider of Owner's Representative services. An Owner's Representative provides project management services representing the interests of the Owner

(the CMSBC) in managing the relationships with the design and construction teams and municipal authorities from design development through construction, move-in, and close-out. These services ensure that the quality of materials and workmanship are in accordance with design specifications and recognized quality standards. The Owner's Representative also manages the process of invoicing and payment, and preparation of submissions for state grant reimbursement.

The Committee approved additional soil strength testing by the Atane Group which was conducted in mid-August to early September; the report of the results was received in early October and can be found on the GPS website, Central Middle School Building Committee, related documents.

The following schedule represents the RFP issuance and selection timeline for Owner's Representative and Architectural Services adopted by the Committee and last revised on October 11. It is subject to possible change.

- 10/24 and 10/25 Candidate interviews Afternoons Starting at 4 pm 7pm
- 11/1 Candidate interviews backup date or vote on finalist
- 11/9 Backup date for vote on finalist if needed
- 11/TBDPresent recommendation for hire to Board of Education for approval
- 11/TBD Execute agreements for architect

The following is estimated timing for the project, as adopted by the committee, and for illustrative purposes only:

- Design: Jan 2023(upon contract engagement with architect) August 2023
- Town/State Funding Approvals: Jan 2023-Dec 2023
- Pre-Construction: Oct 2022-Jan 2024
- RFP for Construction Manager approximately Jan-Feb 2023
- Construction bidding/awards: Jan 2024-May 2024
- Construction: June2024-Feb2026 CofO new building
- Board of Ed occupancy & FFE move-in: March 2026-July 2026
- Demolition of existing building and sitework completion: June 2026-Aug 2026

To date, no funds have been spent by the committee.
