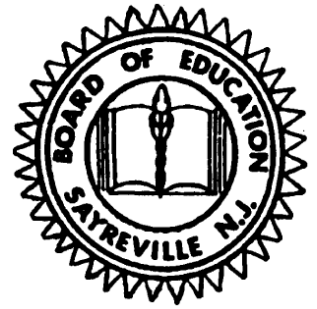

Our Bombers continue to impress in the WordWright National Challenge! Our current sophomores placed third in the nation out of 647 participating districts nationwide!

Six sophomores scored a near-perfect score (only one question wrong out of eleven questions): Sierra Farrell, Alex Gaspar, Alice Mako, Olivia Mandola, Heather McNamara, and Ryan Real. Only 25 students out of the 105,480 who participated attained this score (and we had 6 of those 25!).

Additionally, two freshmen attained a score of 9 out of 11 - a score achieved by only 65 students nationwide out of 90,610 who participated at the freshman level. Those freshmen are Neev Mistry and Muhammad Waraich.
