Thank you School Board Members!

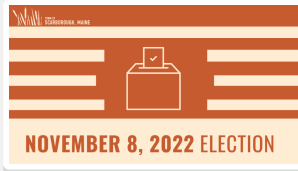

Influenza on the Rise

There has been an increase in influenza both in our schools as well as in Cumberland County. On Thursday, the CDC deemed Scarborough Middle School in outbreak status for Influenza, based on more than 15% of our student body being absent from school due to illness. That designation means that the CDC will continue to monitor absences for our students until we show at least 3 days with less than 15% absences and flu-like symptoms.

Some common symptoms of influenza this year include a runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, fever/body aches, and vomiting or diarrhea. Please keep your student home if they are experiencing any of these symptoms to prevent further spread and do not have them return to school until they are feeling better. It is also recommended that students see their doctor to be tested for the flu if they are feeling ill. Proactively, consider getting the flu vaccine to strengthen your and your child's immunity. Contact your school's nursing clinic if you have any questions or concerns.
