## Educational Visioning Workshops Continue!

During the months of September and October 2022, the Scarborough Primary School Educational Visioning Group (EVG) – a group of Scarborough Public Schools (SPS) leadership and Scarborough primary school administrators, teachers, students, parents, and community partners will participate in three Educational Visioning Workshops run by New Vista Design and Harriman Architects. Each workshop is intended to be a collaborative virtual session to inform the design for a new Scarborough Elementary School facility.

Participants will be led through a step-by-step visioning process aimed at capturing their best thinking about SPS's current and future educational goals and priorities and connecting them to best practices and possibilities in innovative school facility design. All workshops will take place virtually, from 6:00-8:00 PM via Zoom and are designed to be highly participatory, engaging, and informative. The educational and architectural goals set during these workshops will have a direct and tangible impact on the design approach and features of the renovated and/or new school facility.

Although the first session happened last evening, there are 2 more upcoming sessions, and we definitely are interested in having additional members of the larger community be part of this effort,

and more closely involved with giving feedback and creating the vision for this proposed school.

**Workshop Two** will take place on **Monday, September 19, 2022**, from 6:00 – 8:00 PM and explore the following topics:

- Strengths, Challenges, Opportunities, and Goals (SCOG Analysis) associated with SPS's and the primary schools' current academic programming as well as the district's vision for its future
- 21st Century Design Patterns that innovative elementary schools throughout the U.S. have put into practice to make their forward thinking learning goals come alive on the level of facility design Blue Sky Ideas that participants would like to see in new school program and facility

**Workshop Three** will take place on **Tuesday, October 18, 2022**, from 6:00 – 8:00 PM and explore the following topics:

- Guiding Principles for the design of the renovated and/or new facility
- Bubble Diagramming of conceptual design ideas for the renovated and/or new facility
- Key Talking Points that aim communicate the visioning group's priorities and findings to the Scarborough Public Schools community

## We Need Your Help!

**WHY?** Key federal funds are tied to data from these applications. Programs that are impacted from these include:

- Federal Grants for academic support and professional development;
- Federal IDEA grants for students with disabilities;

- Fee waivers for student activities and testing.

Scarborough Public Schools will begin to use the Raptor Visitor Management System in all of our schools to strengthen our program of campus safety for students and staff. Part of keeping students and staff safe is knowing who is in our buildings at all times, and the Raptor system allows us to do that. The Raptor system assists in screening visitors, contractors, and volunteers in our schools and provides a safer environment for our students and staff.

#### What to Expect:

- Upon being allowed through the exterior door of a district building and navigating to the main office as you have always done, visitors will be asked to present a photo ID such as a driver's license.
- Your ID will either be scanned or manually entered into the system by office personnel at the transaction window.
- Once cleared, you will receive a pre-printed badge with your photo on it.
- You will then be directed to the appropriate location that you are going to.
- This badge must be worn at all times when in the building.
- When in the building, you are only approved to go to the specific location requested. You should not go to any other area of the building without returning to the main office for approval.
- When leaving the building, return to the main office and sign out with office personnel.

#### What does the Raptor System do?

- The Raptor system checks to ensure that registered sex offenders are not entering our school campuses without our knowledge. It checks the visitor's name and date of birth for comparison with a national database of registered sex offenders. **The registered sex offender database is the only official database. No other data from the ID is gathered or recorded, and the information is not shared with any outside agency.**
- The Raptor system will also check for any court issued custodial orders, restraining orders and other custom alerts as established by the School District.
- Once entry is approved, a badge that identifies the visitor, the date, and the purpose of his/her visit will be printed and given to the visitor to wear.

The safety of our students is our highest priority, and the Raptor visitor management system allows us to quickly identify those that may present a danger to our students. Thank you in advance for your understanding and your support in enhancing the school safety protocols in our district.
