Senior Reserved Parking & Painting Guidelines

Senior painted parking spaces will be on sale starting August 1st online via the <u>TMHS website</u> and SchoolCash. Seniors will select their parking space when they turn in their required documentation (not including artwork design). All senior painted parking spaces are confined to the designated areas in the Athletics and Fine Arts parking lots as shown on the map below. Spaces are limited.

Procedures for obtaining a parking space & painting guidelines are as follows:

• The cost per parking space is \$100. Payment must be made in order to receive a paintable spot. All payments must be made via the <u>TMHS website</u> and SchoolCash. Spaces will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. When students submit all required documentation (not including artwork design) students will be allowed to select their parking space from the designated areas as shown on the map.

• Your artwork must be submitted to Mr. Gerszewski's office no later than Friday, August 26th for approval. Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that TMHS Administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed. No students will be allowed to paint their space prior to obtaining approval.

• Completed and approved senior parking applications and artwork design must be on file in the office. All forms are available on the <u>TMHS website</u>. In order to follow all city and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces:

• WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the ONLY type of paint that can be used. You may purchase WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint at retail stores such as Sherwin Williams, Lowes or Home Depot. Students who purchase a space that has been previously painted are responsible for any need to cover previous painted design while following paint guidelines.

- NO REFLECTIVE paint.
- NO SPRAY paint.
- Students must keep a 4" unpainted border between the yellow space lines, the spot number, and the paint in their parking spot. (Please use blue painters tape).

All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to Mr. Gerszewski's office by Friday, August 26th for approval. Your design should be clearly drawn on the form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors on any changes that need to be made. All payments must be made online via SchoolCash and your receipt presented when picking up your parking tag.

Dates for painting of the parking spots will be announced soon.
