

Paul & Ruth Schultz Scholarship:



Class of 1987:



\$251,000 Raised! 125% of the Goal Reached!

The 2017-2018 Annual Fund Drive was a phenomenal success thanks to Newman Catholic Schools' many benefactors. The funds raised directly support the general operating budget and help to offset the \$2,900 gap between tuition rates and true costs of education. It is not commonly known that tuition costs only cover approximately 70% of the funds needed to educate each child. This delta is based on variables associated with system operations; compensations, curriculum, facility maintenance, safety and security, etc. Bridging this gap makes reaching the fundraising goal crucial to the success of the system and the health of its finances.

Income and Expenses

Income:

At the close of the 2018 fiscal year, the system continues to have four primary income sources: tuition and fees, parish support, child care, and Advancement respectively. Child care consists of the income earned from enrollment of the six week – 4K programs. Our youngest programs continue to enjoy the strongest growth rates and act as a feeder into the elementary schools. Advancement contributions focus on all fundraising efforts, both system wide and site/club specific, monetary and in-kind donations, and estate gifts.

Expenses:

As witnessed in the accompanying graph, the greatest expense continues to be salaries and benefits at 77% with the remaining 23% spread evenly over all other operating expense categories. Having strong revenue streams is not enough if the system does not act as good stewards of its resources. Through continued analysis and streamlining of processes, NCS avoids overspending and maintains profitability.
