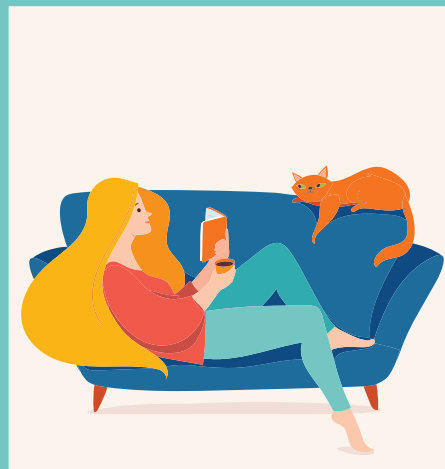

REFUNDS

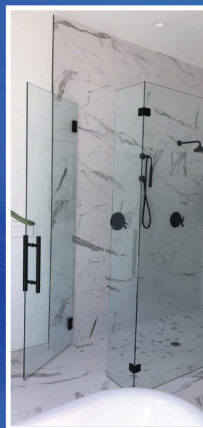

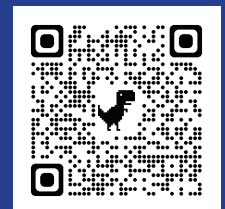
