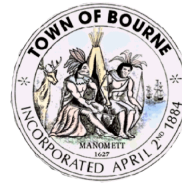

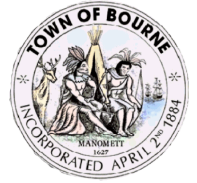
Agenda

1. Approval of Minutes - October
2. BHS Showcase Update - Jessee Clements
Grade 7 and 8 students will spend the day at BHS. They will rotate through a variety of stations related to coursework offered at the high school. Some of the stations include science and forensics, PE and wellness, fine arts, American Sign Language and various clubs. More than 50 high school students have volunteered to help with the stations as well as the teachers and staff from grades 7-8. Students will spend from 8am to 1pm at the high school before returning to the middle school where they will have the opportunity to provide feedback from the day.
3. Career & College Exploration Day - Barbara Starkie
 Bourne High School's First Annual "Career & College Exploration Day"
While the BHS showcase is going on, the remainder of the high school students will attend the first Career and College Exploration Day. Students have a list of 12 learning opportunities to choose from, each focusing on a different career and skill set necessary for the future. Some of the opportunities include: Camp Burgess for cooperative group activities, Tours of local colleges, Ocean Science and technology boat trip, Aviation maintenance at Plymouth municipal airport, Cranberry and Cupcake to learn about local businesses, Local art museums, Mass Maritime Academy, Hiking through conservation areas, Bourne police and fire departments, Cape Cod radio and local media outlets
Dr. Starkie will provide a recap and student feedback at the December meeting.
4. Springboard Update - Jessee Clements and 5. Pre-AP Update - Jessee Clements
Grade 6-10 is implementing Spring Board, Barbara, Lisa and Jessee are meeting with each grade level team to check in and provide support.
