

## PARENT INTERNET VIEWER AVAILABLE

In the spring, selected parents had an opportunity to pilot a new feature of the computer age in school districts. The parents were able to access their student's grades on line. One parent stated, "It was great to be able to see my child's grades on a regular basis without waiting for an interim or report card. I can see how things are going so I am not in the dark."

This feature, called Parent Internet Viewer is available to all parents in the Crestwood Local School District. With this opportunity parents are able to view their child's student records such as grades and attendance on the internet. It is accessible on the **crestwood.sparcc.org website** using a pin code. An individual pin code/password is needed for each child.

With this chance parents are able to check their student's records throughout the academic year. We only ask that parents understand the reality that teachers do not import grades every day. Because of the standards based report card in the primary building the information on line is limited. Also, this information does not replace the official report card or transcript needs at the high school.

If you'd like to have access to Parent Internet Viewer please complete the form below and return it to the office of the building where your child attends. Remember that a pin code is needed for each child. All school fees must be paid to date to receive an access code. Pin numbers will be mailed out once a signed request is received by the parent.
