Information for Pupils and Parents/Guardians

Examination Dates: Monday 9th– Wednesday 18th January 2023

Forms Involved: 4, 5, L6 and U6

Pupils are required to attend all examinations in their subjects and any special sessions arranged by the Head of Form. When they are not in school, they are assumed to be doing private study at home, under the care and responsibility of parents/guardians. **If a pupil is unable to attend school for an examination, parents/guardians are asked to contact the school in the usual manner (use the School Gateway app. or text using the Schoolcomms system: 01287244005).**

There are two examination sessions each day as indicated below. Note that the times are different on Friday 13th January 2023.

Pupils only have to attend those sessions in which they have an examination and must be at the examination venue early enough **to be seated five minutes before the start of a session**. Pupils will be released from the examination venue at the end of an examination paper if this is at an earlier time than the end of the session. Bags are not allowed in the examination venue and pupils are only permitted to leave the examination venue when absolutely necessary.

During a non-examination session, pupils are expected to be studying at home. However, for those pupils who have difficulties with transportation to and from school, there will be a very **limited** amount of space available for study in school.

Pupils are reminded that they must not bring a mobile phone or watch into the examination venue.

Pupils who have missed an examination will be required to do it in **F9** on Thursday 19th January 2023.

There will be no main assemblies from Monday 9th to Thursday 19th January 2023 inclusive.

There will be no Games during the examination period.

Normal classes will resume on Thursday 19th January 2023.

Friday 20th January 2023 is a Staff Development Day.
