

Concepts, Not Commitments

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- We are currently in the *option development* stage of middle school schedules.
- No decisions have been made.
- Feedback Sessions are created to hear from you and get your ideas prior to refining the options and sending them to the District Administrators who will bring a recommended option to the School Board for a decision.
- Implementation planning will occur <u>after</u> a decision is made, with implementation to begin no sooner than fall 2023.
- All options must be viable and meet the Guiding Change parameters.
- This process is about schedules and not courses. While these options give examples of course offerings, course options will be decided during implementation.





Guiding Change for MS Schedule Design - Focus Question: How will we create an aligned, academically/socially/emotionally supportive, and manageable MS schedule across both middle schools?

Context and Reality (The Why)	Unacceptable Means (Not Hows)	Desired Results (The What)
 Current schedules have been in place since 2015. Each middle school currently has four schedules operating within one school (grade 5, grade 6, grade 7 and grade 8), which creates challenges for staffing, subbing and student activities, as well as creates confusion for students and families. Additional challenges with the schedules include but are not limited to: Limits to student electives offered Common planning time Sub requests regularly are unfilled Coordinating Gifted and Talented, Special Ed, ESL and dual identify SPED/ESL services across the different schedules and across teams Conflicts between student intervention needs, student preferences and staff availability. Arts standards requirement Families opting out of intervention due to the impact on students' electives How middle school coursework aligns with career and college pathways at the high school level Both schools are experiencing demographic changes. We continue to see disparities in academic achievement at MS as it is related to race, socioeconomic status, special education and English language learners and gender. Specialist scheduling is strictly limited by the current schedules. The District is committed to "caring relationships, equitable practices and high achievement for all". School schedules play a significant role in affecting student achievement through use of instructional time, social emotional support, and opportunities (such as relationship building, and exploration of interests and careers). The state of MN sets minimum middle school curricular expectations and provides school districts with the authority to require coursework beyond the state minimum. The standards have changed since the last schedule adoption. One of the two schools is an E-STEM magnet (Heritage). Current 5th and 6th grade schedules include more time per class period for	 Violating statutes, board policies or contracts (including master contract for teachers). Advocating for one grade, subject or community over what's best for all students. A new schedule recommendation that is considerably more expensive than the current schedule. Changing current grade configuration for the middle schools. (e.g. one 5-6 building and one 7-8 building) 	 Students have access to rigorous core curriculum. The schedule allows for differentiated intervention (achievement grouping). The schedule includes student choice (personalization). Ability for the schools to balance class size. Students have adequate instructional time in Math and Language Arts - adequate time for reading every day and equitable instruction in these areas w/needed resources and support, (i.e. co-teaching). Accommodates the developmental/social/emotional needs of middle level learners with particular attention to the transitions. Opportunity within the school day/week for relationship/community building. Meets state standards (including new arts standards) and requirements. Allows middle school students to possess the attitudes, skills, and experiences necessary for success in a wide variety of high school, college and career opportunities. The four-way equity test is applied to all options.

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MS Schedule Review Process Timeline



Current Middle School Schedule Summary

- MS School currently runs from 8:45AM to 3:20PM
- Each grade runs on a different schedule, which makes providing Special Education, ESL and other support/intervention to students difficult
- The scheduling of specialists (Music, Spanish, Art, Project Lead the Way, etc.) is particularly challenging in our Middle Schools
- There are 4 lunch periods and a common homeroom time at both schools and all grade levels.

Current Middle School Schedule: Grades 5 & 6

- A 5-period day, or five classes with homeroom, recess and lunch each day
- Four classes are 60- or 63-minutes long (Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies/Writing) depending on the school
- One period of electives, 54 minutes, that is on a 3-day rotation (Music Choice, PhyEd, and Digital Citizenship/Art half year each)

Current Middle School Schedule: Grade 7 & 8 9

- A 6-period day with six 54-minute classes, homeroom and lunch each day
- One period of the following each day: Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Math
- Two periods alternating every other day:
 - Physical Education/Health, Music Choice Band, Orchestra, Choir,
 - Communications, Art/PLTW (half the year each) with exceptions
 - An exception in 7th & 8th grade is AVID, which runs every day
 - An exception in 8th grade is Spanish, which runs every day
- Students in 8th grade have more options, such as the opportunity to take Spanish
