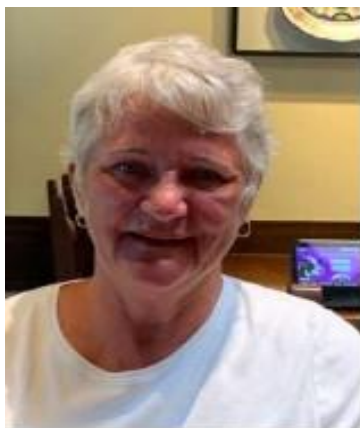
**Christina "Christy" Davis '10**
