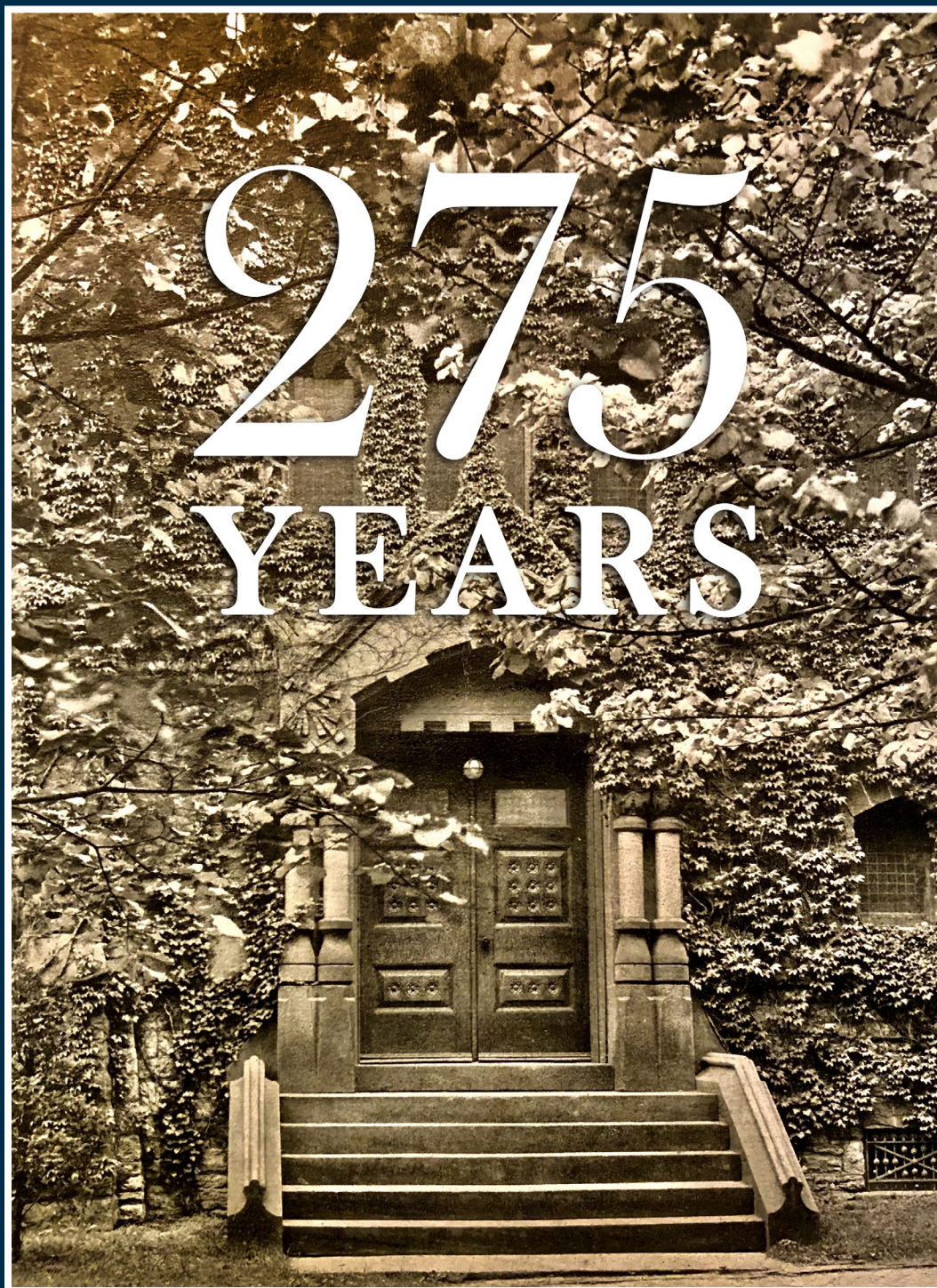

A Message From Our Head of School

Dear Linden Hall family,

It is hard to believe that another school year has come and gone – and this one was a landmark year. Celebrating Linden Hall’s 275th anniversary was so special. From the Gala to signature events like Gretna Day and Alumnae Weekend, we connected our proud past to a very promising future. Everyone enjoyed the walks down memory lane, where we were able to see artifacts from generations gone by and enjoyed the well-articulated commentary from senior and Linden Hall archivist, Grace Remollino ‘22, outlining and reflecting on the major events in our history.



While still dealing with COVID protocols, our students and faculty showed their tenacity, dedication to excellence, and their sheer will to achieve. Again, this year, classes were held in person, and we were so fortunate that our community was healthy; we were healthier this last year across the board than we usually are due to the careful procedures we followed for health and wellness. This year marks a special year for me as I joined Linden Hall as the permanent head of school – the first permanent female leader in the history of the school. I am humbled at this honor and will continue to dedicate my time and talents to ensuring Linden Hall thrives in the coming years.

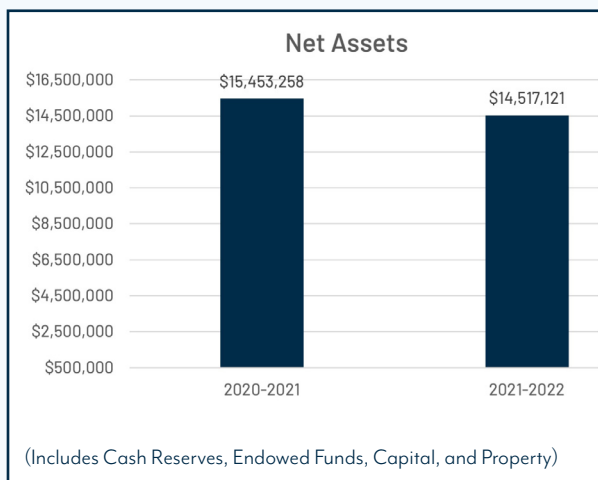
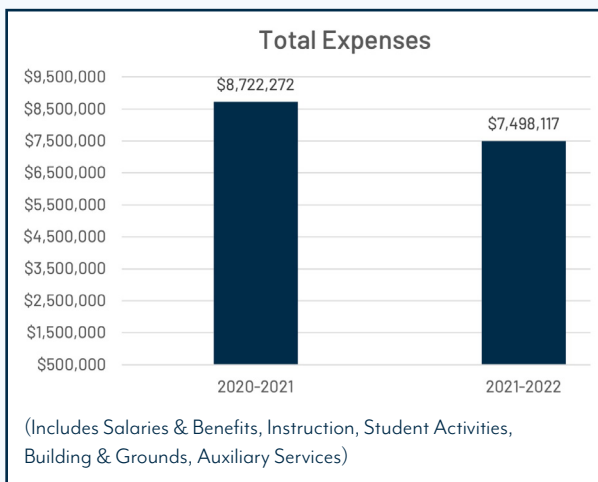
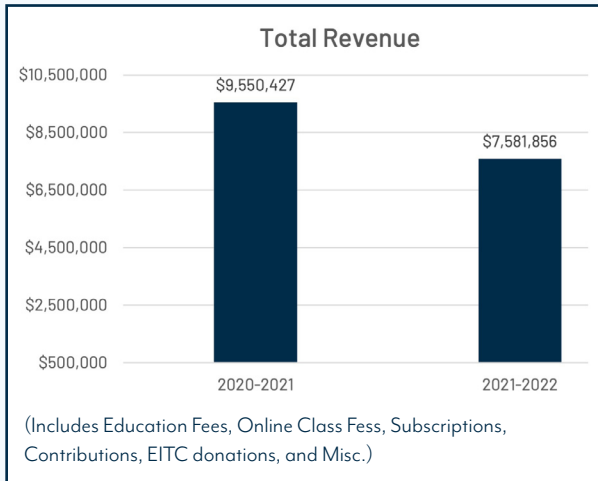

2021-2022 YEAR IN REVIEW



STRATEGICALLY POSITIONING LINDEN HALL

This past year brought many challenges in terms of maintaining our historic campus. The entire air conditioning system in the Evita Allen Academic Building needed to be replaced and many roofs, including the gym, chapel, theater, and science wing needed to be repaired. To prepare for these situations more strategically and effectively, we performed an in-depth analysis of the facility needs over the next ten years. Specifically, we completed a comprehensive audit that outlines the anticipated repair or replacement of everything from roofs to water heaters. This projection allows us to better plan for these expenditures. In addition to the facilities audit, the leadership team, in tandem with the board, developed a budget for that same time period.



What is clear is that the needs of the school are great, and we will have to do significant fundraising to maintain this beautiful campus. In the next two years, the estimated cost of repairs is approximately \$2 million, and over the duration of a ten-year period, we will need to raise an additional \$3 million - and this is just to maintain our facilities, not to enhance them. To accomplish this, our advancement team is working tirelessly to apply for grants, create a planned giving program, and connect with donors who support our mission.

It is through generous donors like you that Linden Hall has been educating young women for more than 275 years. We are grateful for your gifts of time, treasure, and talent, and we look forward to your continued support.

Cross Generational Learning

A Partnership with Moravian Manor

In March of 2019, Linden Hall students first connected with Moravian Manor residents through a COVID-19 pen pal program. Over two years later, the partnership continues to flourish through discussion, service, and friendship. Each month, Linden Hall students gather with Moravian Manor residents to discuss contemporary issues on Zoom or in-person. This year, a community service component was added to the partnership, in which residents and students were able to go out into the community and volunteer together.

During one event, students and residents volunteered at the Wittel Farm and learned about food insecurity in Lancaster County. Together, they harvested over 200 pounds of produce that was given to Water Street Mission's Outreach Center in Lancaster City. In addition to volunteering outside of Moravian Manor, Linden Hall students also established a musical connection. Various students routinely visited residents to discuss their passion for music and to play alongside one another in performances for the Moravian Manor community. Our students were empowered all year long to share experiences across generations, form true mentorships, and partnerships with members of the Lititz Community, and give back to the world outside of the Linden Hall campus.



Maya Planeta '25 Named National Champion



Hosted at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, PA from April 28 – May 1, 2022, riders from across the country gathered for a special 20th Anniversary edition of the Interscholastic Equestrian Association's (IEA) National Finals. Linden Hall's decorated equestrian program, led by 2021 national reserve champion Gloria Wahl '22 and national champion Maya Planeta '25, added to its legacy with yet another stellar showing on the biggest of stages.

Competing as the only freshman in the otherwise upperclassman-dominated Varsity Intermediate Test and Varsity Intermediate Dressage Seat Equitation divisions, Maya Planeta '25 rose to the challenge, outperforming her fellow division riders. Maya placed 1st and earned the title of National Champion in the Varsity Intermediate Test division, while placing 3rd in the Varsity Intermediate Dressage Seat Equitation division. Her performance marks the second straight year that she has earned national championship honors from the Interscholastic Equestrian Association. "Competing at Nationals was a great experience and opportunity for me. I was able to meet people from all over the country, and I am so thankful for Erika Kurtz helping me through my riding journey," Maya said of her experience at Nationals.

Maya's champion-level performance in Harrisburg wrapped up a successful and dominant season. She placed 1st for the Linden Hall High School Team at Regionals – hosted at Linden Hall on March 27, 2022 – in Intermediate Dressage Seat Equitation. She also earned 1st place in the individual divisions of Intermediate Dressage Seat Equitation and Intermediate Test.

The Linden Hall Equestrian Program is led by Trainer Erika Kurtz, who assumed the position as Riding Coordinator in the Fall of 2021 and features riders from the school, as well as from the greater Lancaster County community. Maya's performance at this year's IEA Nationals added yet another championship ribbon to the ever-growing collection housed at Linden Hall's Kaitlin E. Haughey Stables.



Athletics in Review

ARCHERY

The Linden Hall archery team continued to compete at a high level both in Pennsylvania and virtually across the country. The team participated in St. Jude's charity E-tournament, as well as state qualifying tournaments in the Lancaster area. At this year's Lititz Area Mennonite School state qualifier, Jesa Burluson '22 ranked 3rd in the high school girls' division with a score of 262.

BASKETBALL

Varsity Basketball won its fourth straight District III 2A championship defeating Columbia High School, and made it to the Sweet 16 of the PIAA state tournament. Anastasiya Astapenka '22, Nadja Velisavljev '22, Jenadia Jordan '22, and Luna Kirby '22 all committed to play basketball at the collegiate level.

CROSS COUNTRY

Melanie Hahn '23 and Helen Lu '24 both competed at the PIAA District III 1A meet, with Melanie placing 19th overall and finishing with a time of 23:36.4.

EQUESTRIAN

Linden Hall dressage teams hosted Regionals this year and were crowned Reserve Champion. Maya Planeta '25 placed first in Regionals and

advanced to Nationals, where she was named National Champion.

SOCCER

Middle School soccer completed a full competitive season, with Alexa Lindsay '27 leading the team in goals scored.

TENNIS

Varsity Tennis competed in several matches and exhibitions throughout the season. The team finished 6-7 in PIAA games and will join the LL League in the Fall of 2022..

VOLLEYBALL

Varsity Volleyball played a full independent schedule for the first time since 2019 due to the impacts of COVID-19. The team competed well in preparation to join the LL League in the Fall of 2022.

CO-OP SPORTS AT WARWICK HIGH SCHOOL

Linden Hall students competed in Warwick's swimming and track and field programs. Tenra Adams '24, Melanie Hahn '23, and Liz Perot '22 excelled for Warwick's swim team, competing in both district and state meets. Liz swam the 500 Free in the state finals, earning All-State Honorable Mention.

MUSIC

We were thrilled to return to live concerts with in-person audiences this year! Our ensembles performed in our Fall Concert, Vespers, and the Spring Arts Extravaganza. In addition to our concerts, the Choir participated in Musea, and the Orchestra played in Music in the Parks Adjudication. We were so proud of our musicians who received “excellent” and “superior” ratings! Outside of our ensembles, we had an orchestra musician who shared her talents with the instrumentalists at Moravian Manor. This was such a wonderful experience for our students, and we are looking forward to joining them again this school year. We had numerous students participate in county, district, regional and state orchestra and band. They did a fine job of representing Linden Hall at each of these auditions and performances. Six of our senior musicians, Sherry Chen '22, Delaney Gable '22, Rehema Karuri '22, Daisy Paredes '22, Becky Viscusi '22, and Gloria Wahl '22 received recognition from the Lancaster-Lebanon Music Educators Association for outstanding dedication and musicianship.

THEATRE

The best news for our Theater Program is that we were finally able to perform onstage in front of live audiences! Our fall play, *Leaving Iowa*, was a poignant comedy about a family vacation and a son coming to terms with his father's legacy. Our spring production, *PUFFS*, parodied a certain school of wizarding and magic. This well-known play is one of the most produced plays in American high schools and was definitely a crowd pleaser. New inductees in our International Thespian Troupe include Naiyana Camara '22, Naomi Cox '24, Sara Holler '24, Ellen McDaniel '24, Halee Morrissey '24, Daisy Paredes '22, and Rehema Karuri '22. Prior to COVID, our Parents' Arts Boosters had generously provided 30 tickets to Lancaster's Fulton Theatre to see *TITANIC: The Musical*. The tickets were finally used to provide trips to the theater to see four productions. Our students greatly appreciated this opportunity!
