Dear Friends of St. Monica Catholic School,

I am pleased to present the 2021-2022 Annual Report on behalf of our faculty, staff, and administration.

As I begin my sixth year of leadership at St. Monica, I am honored to share all that is special at St. Monica Catholic School. First, we are a community; built on generations of strong faith formation and academic excellence. Our transformation and renewal in the Classical Liberal Arts Pedagogy have gifted us with a growing enrollment that has allowed us the opportunity and blessing of hiring a Vice Principal, Dr. Brett Bertucio. He has been a huge help as our faculty has grown from 12 full-time teachers/staff to an enthusiastic team of 34. Along with supporting the teachers through observation and collaboration, Brett has led the feasibility study into our growing high school course offerings and approval process through the Office of Catholic Schools as the Holy Spirit guides. We are looking to the future and working through the discernment process of officially expanding our school into an accredited PreK-12th grade school. Continuing the Classical Liberal Arts through high school will allow students to master tools for learning, thinking, and communicating, resulting in well-trained minds capable of accomplishing great works, serving, influencing, and leading.

One of the many blessings this past year has been the growth we experienced in enrollment. We have loved welcoming our new families as we continue enhancing the curriculum and instruction pedagogy. The Classical Liberal Arts model allows our students to have more in-depth conversations, think, and problem-solve rather than repeat information handed to them. In addition, this curriculum focus has created excitement in our faculty at the prospect of sharing their love of learning and fostering joy and wonder at the discovery.

As we move forward into our 62nd year of educating future leaders, we are filled with joy as we continue to build upon the strong foundation laid before us. We are so blessed by our ability to bring back the Performing Arts fully, post-pandemic, and we will be renewing the tradition of our Middle School Musical this Spring.

We are deeply grateful to have a supportive parish community and incredibly devoted parents, friends, and alums who do so much to ensure our school's continued success. We are proud of our students, faculty, and staff. We will continue to teach the whole child in a Christ-centered environment to foster and nurture self-discipline and academic excellence. INCOME & EXPENSES



We are pleased to report that our school finished the fiscal year strongly. Our solid financial results were largely due to increased student enrollment and adopting a healthy budgeting model whereby our Monica's Fund and Auction Revenue were included in the upcoming school year operating budget. Historically, the school utilized current-year donations to supplement the current year's operating budget, which substantially improves our financial outlook.

Additionally, instead of using the parish subsidy to supplement our operating budget, the parish was able to support our school with upgraded facility improvements. These projects included new floors in the school foyer, hallways, and middle school classrooms, freshly painted classrooms, and helping fund hiring a new Vice Principal. Lastly, we are happy to report that we were able to continue efforts to increase wages for our teachers and remain competitive in a very challenging labor market. Our teachers' dedication to the school and students was amazing during the 2021-2022 school year.

In consultation with our Parish Finance Council and our School Commission, we continue to review and plan for the best uses of our revenue. Some items on our long-term facility improvements list include a new security system, a heating and cooling system, and new windows for several classrooms. The financial support we receive from our community of parents, alumni, and parishioners directly impact every school student. We are truly grateful for this dedicated community that works together to support our mission of providing an excellent Catholic Classical Liberal Arts education for our children.
