



## Communication Modes in the District - Receiving Text Messages from Our Schools

As many of you may have noticed, there is now an option to receive text messages for communications in the district, in addition to emails or phone messages that the district or your child's school may send.

The first time a message is sent, the system will send messages to all recipients on the list. However, in that message, it prompts users to optin in order to receive any subsequent messages. This is done because
