

Facility Rental Category and Scheduling Information

Category 1 - SCHOOL AFFILIATED GROUPS/RECIPROCAL RELATIONSHIPS

Approved District 86 groups, District 86 feeder student groups, booster clubs, parent associations, other school-affiliated organizations designated by the Board or reciprocal relationships, may use District 86 facilities without charge.

Category 2 - OTHER TAXING BODIES AND IN-DISTRICT NON-PROFIT GROUPS

Public school districts, park districts, incorporated villages and their departments, and any other tax supported body within District 86, as well as local Boy/Girl Scout groups, private schools, religious, cultural, recreational, sports, civic, and other non-profit organizations within District 86 boundaries. All fees will be remitted by the organization utilizing the facility in the form of one payment on behalf of all participants. The District reserves the right to charge any organization separate set-up, clean-up, or monitoring fees, as necessary (please see attached Fee Schedule).

Category 3 - ALL OTHER GROUPS

Any group or activity which is a for-profit group, or does not qualify in Category 1 or Category 2 above, shall be charged a fee sufficient to cover direct costs to District 86 for personnel, utilities, or other out-of-pocket expenses, PLUS a rental charge established by action of the Board (please see attached Fee Schedule).

Scheduling Priority

In scheduling the use of facilities and properties, activities associated with the District 86 educational program shall have priority over the activities of any other organization. Confirmation of lease agreements for Categories 2 and 3 organizations may be withheld until such time as the building activity calendar is completed. Thereafter:

- A. The highest priority shall be accorded to organizations qualifying for Category 1 above and lowest priority accorded to Category 3 above; and
- B. Among organizations of the same category, priority shall be on a first come, first served basis.

II. Conditions of Use

As a condition of use for District 86 facilities by community organizations, the Board requires that all organizations comply with paragraphs 1 through 3 below.
