Highline Centralized COVID Test Sites

Highline COVID Response Team will offer COVID testing on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00-4:15 p.m. at the following locations (but not during school holidays):

Woodside Site: 18367 8th Ave S, Des Moines, WA 98148

Evergreen High School: 830 SW 116th St, Seattle, WA 98146

PCR and rapid antigen testing will be available to students, staff, and household members. PCR tests require patient insurance information. If individuals do not have insurance or do not wish to provide it, they can attest to having no insurance and move forward with a PCR test. If you do not provide your insurance information OR do not attest to not having insurance, you will be offered a rapid antigen test in lieu of a PCR test. More info on the Highline website.

is accessed through both the students g.highlineschools.org account and through the email linked to ParentVue.


Both accounts need to be accessed as the paperwork for the student is different than the paperwork for the parent/guardian.






Visual Art students completed Gratitude Spirals - a fun project to learn some basic watercolor usage and think about gratitude.

<u>Pride Foundation Scholarship</u> (due Jan 6th) --- Pride Foundation provides essential financial resources and community support to LGBTQ+ student leaders across the Northwest.

Ron Brown Scholarship (due Jan 9th) --- For Black/African-American students who are the most talented and economically-challenged high school seniors who demonstrate a keen interest in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship and global citizenship

<u>APIA Scholarship</u> (due Jan 12th) -- For students with heritage from Asia or the Pacific Islands from low-income families. Minimum 2.7 GPA required.

<u>Governor's Scholarship for Foster Youth</u> (due Jan 31st) -- The Washington State Governors' Scholarship for Foster Youth is a scholarship program that helps young men and women from foster care continue their education and earn a college degree.

CSF's Leadership 1000 Scholarship can make your college dreams come true.

CSF's Leadership 1000 Scholarship provides up to \$5,000 per academic year and is renewable up to a maximum of \$20,000. If you are a high school senior on track to graduate from one of these eligible high schools by June 2023, you may be eligible for the CSF Leadership 1000 Scholarship.

Scholarship recipients also receive career and financial aid guidance as well as networking opportunities with CSF alumni and scholarship donors.

This powerful scholarship can be used in pursuit of any major at any of 62 accredited colleges and universities in Washington state.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:

Enrollment plan

- Plan to enroll at least part-time at an eligible Washington state college or university starting fall 2023.
- Plan to pursue a 4-year degree (you can start at a 2-year college with plans to transfer).

Residency

- · Have resided in Washington state for at least one year prior to enrolling in college.
- Be a high school senior at one of these high schools and on track to graduate by June 2023.

-OR-

Be a former Achiever attending eligible Washington state college or university as a freshman, sophomore or junior.

Academic record

- · Have achieved a minimum GPA of 2.50 through fall 2022 term.
- · Have not earned a bachelor's degree.

Financial need

- Have filed a 2023-24 <u>FAFSA</u> (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) or <u>WASFA</u> (Free Washington Application for State Financial Aid).
- Have a total family income that does not exceed 70% of Washington state median family income.

HOW TO APPLY: visit <u>CollegeSuccessFoundation.org/apply</u>. Applicants may start the application, save work and return to complete it later up until the application deadline. Applicants can also invite 'collaborators' who can assist with the application process. We recommend you enter the name and email address of your recommender as early as possible to give your recommender time to submit a letter for you.
