At St. Joseph High School, we fully understand and appreciate the significant financial commitment families make in deciding to provide their children with a private school education. We are committed to enrolling qualified candidates from all socioeconomic backgrounds and offer a financial aid program based on each family's demonstrated need.

St. Joseph High School works with FACTS Management for Financial Aid review. FACTS uses a formula to compute a family's estimated contribution to a private school education. Our Financial Aid Team considers the FACTS recommendation and then conducts a more in-depth evaluation to provide an aid award based on available financial aid funds.

Please know that St. Joseph High School is not able to provide aid to all qualified applicants, and, unfortunately, some may be placed on a waitlist or even denied financial aid as the requests for need-based aid invariably outweigh the availability of funds.

### **APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID**

In order to be considered for financial aid, you must file and complete a FACTS application by November 15, 2023. The FACTS application will require tax information and income verification. ### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

St. Joseph High School offers several academic scholarships to incoming freshmen, ranging from \$3,000 to half tuition and are renewed each year of attendance. Applicants who submit an admission application by November 15, 2023 are automatically considered for scholarship. To be considered, students must score within the 90th percentile or higher on the freshman entrance exam. St. Joseph High School does not offer athletic scholarships.

## TUITION AGREEMENT & PAYMENT TIMELINE

- ◇ **November 15, 2023** – Priority Deadline for Admission and FACTS Financial Aid applications. All admission applicants who complete an application by November 16 are automatically considered for scholarship opportunities at SJHS as well.
- ◇ **Mid-December 2023** – Aid and scholarship awards will be included in a student’s acceptance package.
- ◇ **February 7, 2024** – Freshman Enrollment Deadline. Students submit an enrollment contract and \$1,000 fee (\$900 payment toward tuition, \$100 registration fee).
- ◇ **March 2024** – Our Board of Directors meet annually to set tuition for the coming school year. They are judicious in considering any increase and are particularly sensitive to economic pressures as well as your tuition investment. The average increase is 3-5% annually.
- ◇ **April 2024** – Each family will receive a personalized tuition agreement and invoice via mail; payments (for all payment plans) begin on June 1, 2024. Your tuition agreement is personalized and your invoice will reflect your enrollment deposit paid as well as financial aid or scholarship that may apply.
- ◇ **May 1, 2024** – Your tuition agreement paperwork will allow you to select one of three payment options (payment in full, by semester, or monthly). You must return your payment option selection and signed agreement by May 1.
- ◇ **June 1, 2024** – Your first tuition payment is due.

# BUDGET OPTIONS FOR ALL FAMILIES

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

- ◇ **Tuition Includes** all textbooks, club, and sport participation\*.
- ◇ **2nd Child Discount** - Full tuition is charged for the first student, a \$250.00 discount is automatically applied for each additional student.

The following totals are calculated using the tuition cost for the 2023-24 school year *without* financial aid or scholarship.

<b>One Payment</b>	<b>Due June 1</b>	<b>\$18,500</b>
<b>Payment by Semester</b>	<b>Due June 1 &amp; December 1</b>	<b>\$9,250 per semester</b>
<b>Monthly payments (via Union Savings Bank Loan, 5.50% interest)</b>	<b>Due monthly (June 1 - April 30)</b>	<b>\$1,774 per month</b>

## OTHER COSTS TO CONSIDER:

- ◇ **Uniform** - Items can be purchased from our bookstore or Blake's Uniform Store, and some items can be purchased from other retailers. Gently used uniforms will be available this summer during our Uniform Swap event free of charge.
- ◇ **Electronic Device** - Plan ahead to purchase an iPad, ChromeBook, laptop, or other device if you do not already own one. St. Joes does not sell or rent devices. Your student’s device is their property and responsibility.
- ◇ **Supplies** – St. Joes does not prepare a school supply list. We suggest that your student continue to use the note-taking and organizational system that is currently working for them (binders/notebooks, etc).
- ◇ **Lunch** - Some students choose to bring a lunch from home, some choose to purchase lunch at school. We are catered by Catamount Catering and fresh options are prepared on site daily. Breakfast and Lunch items range from \$3-\$10. Students can purchase lunch with cash or with their student ID.
- ◇ **Bus Transportation (optional)** - There is a \$600/semester bus fee for students utilizing one of our four SJ Buses. Trumbull residents are provided free bussing from the Town.
