#### 7-11-4487 PARTICIPATION AT SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The Board recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express concerns regarding agenda items.

To permit fair and orderly public expression, the Board will provide a period for public comments at regular public meetings of the Board on meeting agenda items only.

The presiding officer of each Board meeting at which public participation is permitted shall administer the procedures of the Board for its conduct.

Comments will be limited to Board meeting agenda items with a time limit of 3-5 minutes.

The presiding officer shall be guided by the following rules:

- A. Public participation shall only be allowed during the time of public comments on the agenda.
- B. Participants must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface their comments by an announcement of their name, address, group affiliation and which agenda item they wish to address.
- C. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer; no person may address or question Board members individually.
- D. The presiding officer shall:
  - a. Interrupt, warn or terminate a person's statement when the statement is a complaint against any employee, or is too lengthy, personally directed, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant.
  - b. Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;
  - c. Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that persons conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting;
  - d. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; Waive these rules with the approval of the Board when necessary for the protection of privacy, rights of any Board member or employee, or the administration of the Board's business.
- E. A Board meeting is a meeting in public, not a public meeting.

#### 2022-2023 Return to School Plan

State and Federal Mandates require schools to review and update their return to school plans every six months. The return to school plan is in relation to how we will handle COVID. The suggested plan is below. This is the same plan we used from mid February throughout the rest of the 21-22 school year. If you have any input or comments concerning this plan, feel free to email Superintendent Trent Provo at tprovo@egreene.k12.in.us. Or you can email one of our board members. Their contact information can be found on the corporation website. Our Return to School Plan will be adopted at the July 11 board meeting.

- The attendance plan for Eastern Greene Schools will be in-person. This would only change if we were advised to close school(s) due to an outbreak of an illness that fits the DOE or Greene County Health Department definition of an outbreak.
- We will no longer contact trace or quarantine students if they are a close contact to a Covid positive individual.
- Masks will be **optional** in all Eastern Greene buildings and at all events.
- If a student or staff member is positive for Covid they will isolate for five days and can return on day 6. They must wear a mask for days 6-10 when they are around others. This includes all extracurricular activities.
- A negative test or doctor's note **is not** required to return to school.
- We will go back to our pre-pandemic policy concerning illness. Students should not come to school if they are feeling ill. They should definitely not attend school if they have a fever (100.4 or higher), are vomiting, or have diarrhea. They should be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication to return to school.
- If your student is a close contact to a positive case in the home, or elsewhere, and you are considering a self-imposed quarantine, please contact your student's building nurse and principal as this can affect attendance.
- If your student must isolate due to a positive COVID test, please contact your student's principal to arrange the best plan to continue their education. If you have reliable internet your student may be able to remotely attend classes.
- This plan is subject to change due to changes in national, state, or local emergency health mandates and/or changes in the number of local COVID cases and/or quarantines.

July 11, 2022

Regular July Board Meeting (Monday) Review/Approve Budget Calendar.

August 8, 2022

Regular August Board Meeting (Monday) Request permission to advertise the 2023 Budget.

Advertise the 2023 Budget on Gateway Budget Web-site and Hearing Notice for Capital Projects Plan and the School Bus Replacement Plan posted on the corporation website. <u>Must be ten days prior to the public hearing on the budget.</u> The last allowable date for the first publication is October 12, 2022.

September 12, 2022

Regular September Board Meeting for public hearing on the 2023 Budget Capital Projects Plan, and School Bus Replacement Plan. <u>Must be at least ten days before the adoption date.</u> The last allowable date for the public hearing is October 22, 2022.

October 10, 2022

Regular October Board Meeting. Adoption of the 2023 Budget, Capital Projects Plan, School Bus Replacement Plan, and the Budget Resolutions. <u>Must be at least ten days between the public hearing and the adoption</u>. The last allowable date for adoption is November 1, 2022.

October 15, 2021

Submit via Gateway the 2022 Budget. The last allowable date to submit forms to Gateway is November 8, 2022.
