OSHKOSH AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT PROJECT PROGRESS REPORT

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

At Vel Phillips Middle School, the continued progress of the building structure is evident in the walls and steel rising on the West side of the building. In addition to the building rising, the curb and gutter work for the new parking lot is nearly complete, with the first layer of asphalt down to allow for temporary parking for contractors. Putting this first layer of asphalt down has worked successfully in past projects to be a temporary surface, and then the final coat of asphalt will be installed in the summer of 2023. Continued work at the stormwater detention ponds and relocation of utilities on the North side of the Vel Phillips site are still ongoing.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

For the new elementary school project, design work continues to be in full swing. The OASD and Bray Architects have made good progress with implementing the design intent on both the exterior and interior of the building. A second user group meeting was held in late June. OASD Administrators and Bray Architects met with staff from Webster Stanley, Merrill, and Washington elementary schools. The purpose of the meeting was to get feedback on the building design and layout in order to best accommodate the day-to-day needs of the school community.

For the Vel Phillips Middle School project, the OASD partnered with Bray Architects to develop environmental graphics and branding that will bring the school community to life. The design work on this is now complete, and over the next few months the District will be sharing renderings that spotlight the design efforts.
