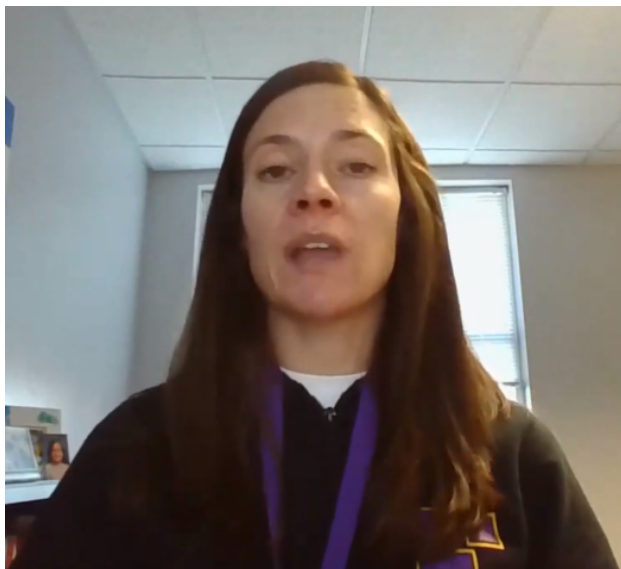

with students learning English as their second language; and Mrs. Rada who teaches middle level ELA.

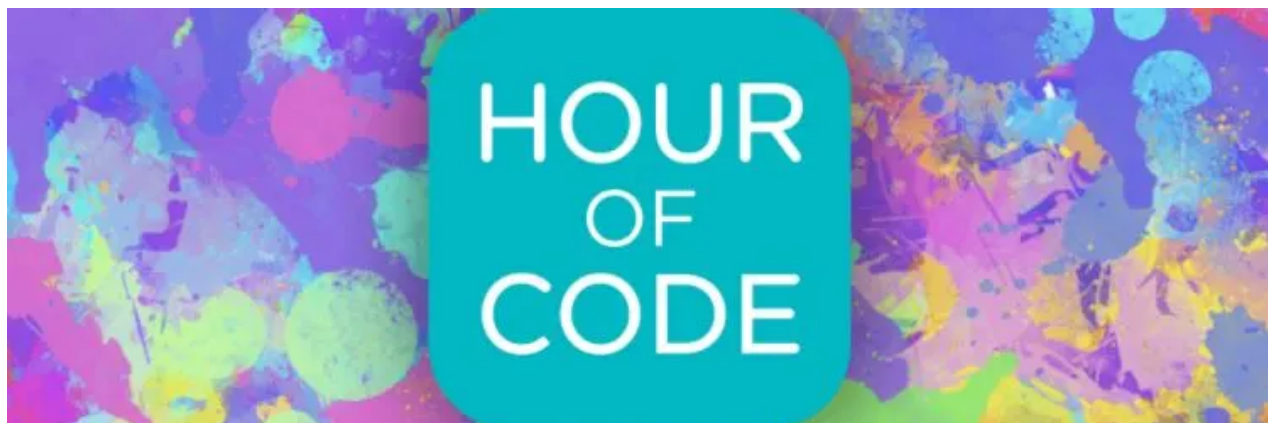
Equity Club

Game Night

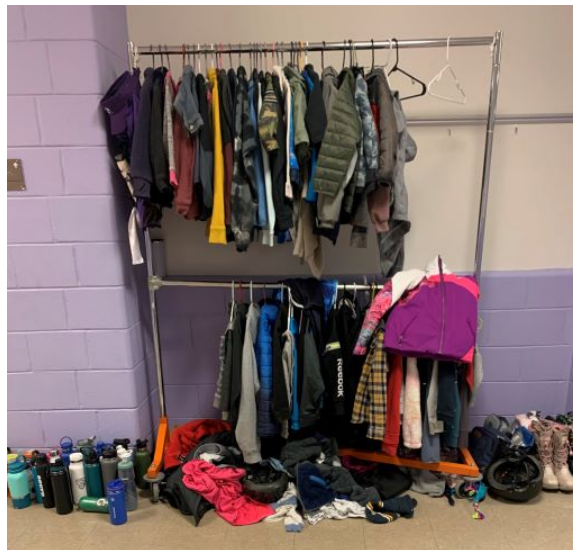
What a fun night!! Thank you to everyone who joined us for Game Night, Hot Cocoa and Cookies! It was a great turn out and so much fun.
