Entry Criteria

8th Graders looking to enter the program should have...

- Completion of 1 High School Credit
 - Complete Algebra 1 or Geometry with a C or higher
- A GPA of at least a 3.0
- Qualifying Reading/Writing PERT scores*
- Submission of entry interview questions

*Initial qualifying PERT scores include a 106 on the Reading and a 103 on the Writing. A Math score of a 114-123 will be required by their 11th grade year.
