

Hello!

My name is Heidi Anderton, I am the Health Professions Advisor at Davis Technical College (DTC). I am excited to hear of your interest in the Nursing Assistant program. Information on the program, class dates and tuition information can be found on our website: <https://www.davistech.edu/nursing-assistant>.

The Nursing Assistant program is open to qualified high school students. Classes are offered at the DTC campus or Clearfield High School. Our DTC-campus classes are offered full time and part time (day and evening and are set up to run hybrid. What this means is you must be available to attend virtually during scheduled class times. Please see website for start dates. Clearfield High School classes are in-person only, hybrid schedules are not available.

There will be hands-on components of this program that will require students to meet in smaller groups. These groups will require organization and teamwork which will closely resemble the workplace. Students are required to complete 24 clinical hours at a Skilled Nursing Facility.

The first step is to meet the requirements for the program. These requirements can be found on the webpage. Please review the webpage carefully, including Cost Summary, Financial Aid, and Admission Requirements (specifically immunization requirements).

If you meet the requirements listed on the webpage, the next step is to register as a Davis Tech student.

Below, you will find an "At-a-Glance" overview of the Nursing Assistant application process

1: **Meet the programmatic requirements:**

Requirements for the Nurse Assistant program can be found on the website at <https://www.davistech.edu/nursing-assistant>

- High School Students: Must have a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- High School Students must be 16 years old on or before first day of class and in junior year.
- Must be current on immunizations – **see admissions requirements on website.**
 - ✓ **Hepatitis B series**
 - ✓ **TB Test** (This needs to be done within one year of your clinical's. This test can be done at the Health Dept. or family practice provider. This test requires 2 visits to your doctor)
 - ✓ **Seasonal Influenza** (Flu season runs October- April, you must have verification of receiving THIS SEASON' S flu vaccine)
 - ✓ **COVID-19** complete series, recommended. Please know, Covid-19 vaccination is required by most clinical sites. Proof of two-dose primary series, plus booster. If not immunized, it is the responsibility of the student to provide a signed exemption, and a face shield and mask must be always worn during clinical shifts. This is subject to change per the guidelines and directive of the Department of Health and our clinical facilities.

2: **Register as a Davis Tech College student:**

To register as a student, please follow the steps below:

1. Visit DTC website at www.davistech.edu and click on the orange tab labeled **NEXT STEPS** or simply follow this link: <https://www.davistech.edu/next-steps>.
2. Click the big red **ENROLL AT DAVIS TECH** button
3. Click the '**Sign Up**' button at the bottom of the frame

4. Enter name and email address.
5. You will receive an email with a link to create a password. Your password must contain 8 characters and contain both letters and numbers.
6. Return to site, enter credentials, and click blue **START A NEW APPLICATION** button to begin application process.

3: **Admission Testing**

The Assessment Center is located inside Student Services in the main building at Davis Tech. For specific questions regarding test options and hours please contact the Assessment at 801-593-2361 or follow this link: <https://www.davistech.edu/assessment-center/>

- **High School Students:** Assessment testing may be waived depending on grades received in recent English and Math courses. Applicants must submit transcripts to the Assessment Center to have their testing waived. High school students attend Davis Technical College tuition free, however any applicable fees and lab fees related to the program are not considered tuition and are the responsibility of the student. High school students must be enrolled as Davis Tech students. There is a \$40 application fee for all high school students.

4: **Complete Online Application:**

Interested candidates must complete the online application. To complete the application, return to site, enter credentials, and click blue **START A NEW APPLICATION** button to begin application process.
